RULES:

1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Freestyle Alberta (FA) in partnership with Canyon Ski resort and Freestyle Canada (FC).
2. Rules are based on Can Freestyle Competition Guidelines for Canada Cup events.
3. The Competition is comprised of one Mogul and one Dual Mogul event.
4. All athletes must have a minimum Can Freestyle certified Air 4 Coach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury.
5. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.
6. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

FORMAT OF EVENT:

SINGLE:

- 2 Qualification runs, best of 2 advances to final.
- Q2: Same run order.
- FINALS: Max of 16 athletes total for finals (Gender split determined at TCM based on gender ratio)

DUALS:

- QUALIFICATION: Single run.
- FINAL: Up to top 32 seeded from qualification.

**Formats and Finals field size can be adjusted by the Jury in consultation with a Freestyle Canada staff member.

The competition office will be located in the Main Lodge. Please check in each day of the event at the competition office to sign in, pick up your bib, purchase lift tickets, start lists and receive updates on event schedule.

Lift Tickets: All tickets must be pre-purchased online no less than 24 hours in advance and Walk ups to buy athlete tickets at the ticket window will not be allowed.

Coaches will pick up each athlete's lift ticket from the competition office. The cost of a lift ticket is \$39.00/day + GST. Athletes can purchase from 1-4 days by adding days into their cart. Each competitor and coach is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event. **Lift tickets are non-refundable.**

Registration:

The Canyon Ski Resort Canada Cup follows the Priority registration policy for PSO teams and HPAD athletes as described in the Freestyle Canada Cup guidelines.

- OPEN Registration Entries to be received by Jan. 26th, 2023, 8:00 am MST.

Entries must be received no later than 48 hours before the first Team Leaders' Meeting.

Entry Fee (per participant):

- \$260.00 + 5% GST and SnowReg fees
- Participants must register on-line individually. Payments are made online.
- Registration closes on January 26th or when the event is full.

Membership Requirement:

Athletes are required to have a **minimum Provincial Athlete Membership**

Competition office:

The competition office will be located in the Main Lodge at Canyon Ski Resort.

Bibs:

- will be included in the event registration. ALL coaches must check in their athletes on their behalf and collect their teams' bibs (only coaches and event personal will be allowed in the competition office)
- must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

Bib Pickup:

Bibs can be picked up on Thursday Feb. 2, 2023 at the registration office by the athletes coach.

Bibs:

Bibs are included in the athlete's registration. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be a \$35 + GST replacement fee. If an athlete forgets their bib and brings the bib back the next day, there will be no refund. Bibs will be available for purchase at the competition office during the event, should an athlete lose or forget their bib it must be picked up by the coach. It is important that your bib number match your event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure your coach updates the on-site race office. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competition.

Refund Policy: Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury the coach must notify the registration desk, to inform that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the Team Captains meeting the day before competition day. In this case athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is canceled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided. (The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event)

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in **all disciplines**. The FC Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during Team Leaders meeting the day before each event with the **coach** of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passports held by coach/athlete
- Completed and signed qualification forms
- FC qualification databank

Liability and Accident Insurance: All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the maneuvers being performed in training and competition. All athletes' coaches and officials must have a valid FC Membership. The Organizing Committee, Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, Freestyle Alberta Ski Association, Canyon Ski Resort and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.
