2. The competition is comprised of two (2) events: Halfpipe (2x)
3. All athletes participating in the HP/SS Nor-Am at WinSport's Canada Olympic Park must have a valid FIS license issued under the authority of their national ski association.

Quotas

The quotas for the Nor-Am Cup Tour for HP/SS (BA) events are as follows

***Foreign nations entries must be submitted by the deadline outlined in [CoC rule 2.2.1](#) using the official FIS Entry Form. Foreign nation entries will be confirmed upon payment receipt.**

Lift Tickets

Lift tickets will be available for purchase each day of training and competition at the WinSport Guest Services ticket window. (online purchases TBD) Athletes will need a Hill ticket and XL Park ticket to access the halfpipe.

Competition Price:

- 1) Hill Ticket: \$34 CAD/day + 5% tax** (does NOT include XL Park where the competition being held, does include West Line Park)
plus:
- 2) XL Park Ticket: \$30 CAD/day + 5% tax**

There are no refunds. To qualify for this competition pricing, athletes must appear on the registration list at Guest Services. Each competitor must have a valid lift ticket and [XL park ticket/pass](#) to the venues for each day of the event. Hill and XL Park tickets /passes are non-transferable.

Coaches and official's hill & XL park ticket: Free and available at registration office or guest services (2 per team).

Waivers

A signed waiver must be completed for each XL Park user before accessing the park. Sign the waiver before arriving at the ticket window.

Bib Deposit

There will be a \$20 CAD CASH ONLY bib deposit. If a bib is lost or forgotten, there will be a \$20 replacement fee. An athlete's bib number must match event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

Halfpipe Format

Halfpipe will consist of best of 2 runs qualification and a best of 2 runs final.

The jury can determine the format, based on the number of competitors in the qualifications by gender and time schedule. This decision must be made before and will be announced at the first team captain's meeting.

Cash prizes will be paid on-site at awards. The prize estimate is as follows:
