INVITATION

Central Alberta Freestyle Ski Club is pleased to be hosting a Provincial Competition this season on a brand new mogul course called Check Mate. We are inviting all Train-to-Train athletes to participate in the competition. This Moguls competition is stop number 4 in the Freestyle Alberta Provincial series.

Rules

- 1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Central Alberta Freestyle Ski Club in partnership with Freestyle Alberta.
- 2. The competition is comprised of two events, Moguls and Moguls.
- 3. All athletes must have a Can Free 3 license or higher.
- 4. All athletes must have a FC certified Coach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the event jury.
- 5. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.
- 6. Entry for moguls and moguls are based on Provincial Series quotas with freestyle club head coach referrals.
- 7. The competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Officials Program.

Athlete CFSA License/Membership

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<u>Volunteering</u>

The success of all events through out the season depends on volunteers. Volunteers are needed for course prep and event positions. Lift Tickets

Lift tickets will be available for purchase for training and competition days at Guest Services with presentation of competitor bib, cost is \$35 plus GST.

Each competitor is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event.

<u>Athlete Bio Sheet</u>

Athlete bio's are mandatory at the time of registration – no bio – NO BIB. Athlete bio is attached and will also be available at the registration desk.

<u>Bibs</u>

There will be a \$20 bib deposit. Cash only please. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be a \$20.00 replacement fee. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

Event Cancellation

If an event is cancelled each athlete will be refunded all but \$30 of the entry fee. This is because the organizing committee still needs to pay the officials a portion of their compensation.

Injury Refund

Should an athlete get injured during official training for the event and cannot complete, the athlete will be refunded everything except a \$30 administration fee. An injury refund request must be accompanied by a CFSA accident report from the coach and submitted to the registrar prior to running the start list. NO refunds will be processed after the event's start list has been generated.

Aerial Qualifications

All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during Team Leaders meeting the day before each event with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- 1. Signed Aerial Passports held by coach/athlete
- 2. Completed and signed qualification forms
- 3. CFSA qualification databank





Liability and Accident Insurance

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the maneuvers being performance in training and competition, as well as a valid FC membership. The Organizing Committee, FC, FA, Central Alberta Freestyle Ski Club and Canyon Ski Resort shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second or third party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times. All competitors must wear helmets and competition bibs.

Age Categories

Athlete's age for the purpose of categories is determined by their age on January 1. Medals will be awarded for U14, U16, U18 and U20 age categories. Under age athletes will compete in the U14 category.

U14: 12 and 13 years of age on January 1st, 2018 U16: 14 and 15 years of age on January 1st, 2018 U18: 16 and 17 years of age on January 1st, 2018 U20: 18 and 19 years of age on January 1st, 2018

<u>Banquet</u>

The banquet will be on **Saturday February 24**th at Canyon Ski Resort. The banquet will include dining, awards, silent auction and 50/50 draw.

Doors will open at 5:30 pm with dinner at 6:00 pm.

There will be a cash bar.

There will be a silent auction and a 50/50 draw.

Banquet tickets are \$30 per person and children 5 and under are free.
