REGISTRATION INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES	\$140 for one (1) event; \$170 for two (2) events Entries must be received no later than Friday, February 2. Please submit one registration form per club (form provided). All registrations are to be sent to info@calgaryfreeriderz.com .		
BIB DEPOSIT	\$20 CASH ONLY bib deposit If a bib is lost or forgotten, there will be a \$20 replacement fee. An athlete's bib number must match event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all open and official training and for the competitions.		
LIFT TICKETS	Event participants will receive a 20% discount for Event Days only (Sunday & Monday); this includes competitors, coaches, and parents. Discount to be applied upon presentation of the athlete's bib when purchasing from Guest Services. <ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ For parents of athletes a maximum of two (2) tickets per day.▶ Each registered team is eligible for one (1) complimentary coach lift ticket per Event Day.		
AGE CATEGORIES	According to the birth year as of January 1st, 2018, all athletes will compete in the age categories of U20, U18, U16, or U14. Under age athletes will compete in the U14 category. <ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ U20 Athletes born in 1998 or 1999▶ U18 Athletes born in 2000 or 2001▶ U16 Athletes born in 2002 or 2003▶ U14 Athletes born in 2004 (or later)		
ATHLETE BIOS & PHOTO USE	Athlete bios are mandatory at the time of registration, <i>no bio ... no bib</i> . Bio sheet is attached and copies will be available at the Registration Desk. Calgary Freeriderz will be taking and using photos of the event and its participants. If an athlete wishes to be exempt, please note on athlete's bio upon submittal to the Registration Desk.		

RULES

These events are sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Calgary Freeriderz in partnership with Freestyle Alberta.

- ▶ All athletes must have a Can Free 3 license or higher.
- ▶ All athletes must have a Freestyle Canada certified Coach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury.
- ▶ Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials, organizers and other members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Calgary Freeriderz, The Lake Louise Ski Resort, Freestyle Canada and Alberta Freestyle Skiing Association and any Sponsors, shall not be responsible for any issue with the organisation or staging of the event including, but not limited to: accidents; damaged or lost equipment and belongings; and/or second or third-party claims. All participants are to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times. All competitors must wear helmets and competition bibs.

Athletes MUST be registered as current Freestyle Canada members. The athlete's home club is responsible for ensuring current and appropriate Freestyle Canada membership.

ACCIDENTAL INSURANCE

Every competitor should have his/her own medical insurance. The Calgary Freeriderz, Alberta Freestyle Skiing Association, any Sponsors, and The Lake Louise Ski Resort decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third-party claims during the staging of the event.

Volunteers should be registered as current Freestyle Canada associate members or Officials and Judges have relevant membership for insurance.

REFUNDS

Refunds will be processed for withdrawals prior to the generation of the competition start list less a \$30 administration fee. After the generation of the start list the event refund policy is as follows:

- ▶ **Event Cancellation:** If a competition is cancelled due to weather or for exceptional circumstances athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event.
- ▶ **Injury Refund Policy:** A registered athlete who withdraws from an event before the generation of the start list will receive a refund less a \$30 administration fee. Athletes that appear on the official start list for an event will not be given a refund. In case of an injury the coach or parent must notify the Registration Desk or info@calgaryfreeriderz.com to inform them that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the Team Captains meeting the day before the competition day.
- ▶ **Extraordinary Circumstances:** Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of The Organizing Committee. NO refunds will be given without a written request received no later than 7 days after the completion of the last event day.

Tickets for this fun event must be purchased at the time of registration, as none will be available for purchase at the event. Tickets are \$25.00/person (13 and up) or \$15.00/person (12 and under).
