In 2017 **FFSC** majorly invested in it's Mogul pitch with over \$17K worth of dirt work which has created a World Class site with an average grade of 26 degrees and course length of 234 meters. We have a site that will be able to attract a Canadian Series, NORAM or World Cup.

Delivering over 2500 acres of skiable terrain, up to 37 feet of snow in a season, 142 named runs and 5 alpine bowls. Fernie is a true venue for BIG MOUNTAIN terrain. Epic snow. Big lines. Vast mountains.


SLOPESTYLE

For the 2017-2018 season **FFSC** has incorporated our rails into the terrain park at Fernie Alpine Resort and they are currently managed and facilitated by the Rail Team and our coaches. We have many future options and truly untapped potential for this discipline.



The Candidate

Ideally our new Head Coach should live in Fernie, BC or a surrounding community. Candidates must also have the ability to travel to various other ski resorts in Alberta or British Columbia for competitions or training events. Training days are centralized around weekends from December to April at Fernie Alpine Resort. **FFSC** also arranges mid-week training at Canada Olympic Park so great organizational skills are needed to manage these athletes during the ski season. Summer ski camps on the Whistler Glacier as well as water ramp sessions in the Okanagan or Central Alberta are also a possibility.





This is a contract based job that runs from September 1, 2018 - April 30, 2019 with the possibility of renewal or a longer term contract being offered after the first season.
