Registration & Competition Rules

Registration: Registration Deadline is Wednesday, January 16th, 2019. Please submit your registration form by email to Jody Gardiner at <u>jasperfreeridereg@gmail.com</u>. Clubs will be registered on a first come first serve basis. Please register early to avoid disappointment.

<u>Timber Tour Provincial Moguls Entry Fees:</u> \$160.00 per athlete covers both events. * Entry to MO/MO is based on Provincial Series quotas with freestyle club head coach referrals.

<u>Timber Tour Club Competition Entry Fees:</u> \$100.00 per athlete covers both events. Club field size will be limited to 75 athletes.

- * Coaches must RSVP for Club Mogul Training on Thursday. We require 30 Club athletes for this training session to run. If we don't receive this many, the Thursday schedule will change to allow more time for the Provincial athletes.
- ** Athletes that are entered in Provincial moguls can not enter in Club level events as well.

Payment: Team Representative/Coaches are required to submit payment, providing one team cheque for all registration and banquet fees, on Thursday (Jan 31st) during times indicated on schedule, at the registration desk at Marmot Basin's Lower Caribou Chalet. Cheques can be made payable to 'Jasper Freeride Ski Team'

Rules:

This event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Jasper Freeride Ski Club in partnership with Freestyle Alberta. The event is compromised of three events - provincial moguls, aussie rules club moguls and club slopestyle. All athletes must have a FC Certified coach present with Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. Entry for MO/MO is based on Provincial Series quotas with freestyle club head coach referrals.

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up to date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athletes qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:





- signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

Age Categories:

Provincial Moguls - Athlete's age for the purpose of categories is determined by their age on January 1, 2019. Medals will be awarded for U14, U16, U18 & U20 age categories. Underage athletes will compete in the U14 category.

- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2019
- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1st, 2019
- U18: 16 & 17 years of age as of January 1st, 2019
- U20: 18 & 19 years of age as of January 1st, 2019

Club Competition (Slopestyle & Moguls) - Athlete's age for the purpose of categories is determined by their age on January 1, 2019. Medals will be awarded for U10, U12, U14, U16 age categories. Underage athletes will compete in the U10 category.

- U10: 8 & 9 years of age as of January 1st, 2019
- U12: 10 & 11 years of age as of January 1st, 2019
- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2019
- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1st, 2019

<u>Athlete CFSA License / Membership:</u> All athletes must have a valid CFSA license to compete.

- CanFree 3 is required for provincial level
- CanFree 1 or 2 is required for club level

<u>**Bibs**</u>: Freestyle Alberta provincial bibs will be provided for the Provincial Competition. Numbers will be assigned by the event organizing committee. For the Club Competition, clubs are asked to provide their own athletes with bibs

and indicate each athlete's bib number on registration form by January 16th registration deadline. If clubs do not have access to bibs, Jasper Freeride can loan bibs. For all bibs, a cash deposit of \$20.00 per bib is required and will be refunded upon bib return.





<u>Bios</u>: Please submit completed athlete bios at time of registration. Bio sheet is included in email invite.

Banquet (Saturday February 2nd): Please extend the banquet invite to your club membership in advance of registration deadline, and identify number of tickets on registration sheet. The banquet will be held at the Jasper Activity Center (303 Pyramid Ave). We will be hosting silent auction and a cash bar with wine & beer. Doors open 6:00 pm with dinner at 6:30 pm followed by awards. Banquet ticket prices: \$25.00 for 13 years and over, \$15.00 for 5 to 12 years of age, Free for 4 years of age and under. Banquet tickets can not be returned after they have been paid for.

<u>Lift Tickets:</u> Competitors and families: Tickets may be purchased at the Marmot Ticket Sales Windows (lower chalet parking lot). Best deal: For season pass holders (from a ski hill with reciprocal agreement) show your ski pass to receive 20% off regular price (taxes not included), otherwise registered athletes can get 10% off of regular lift prices. Please refer to this link for regular prices: skimarmot.com. <u>Team Coaches</u>: For every 10 athletes registered from your club, 1 complementary ticket is available for a team coach. This is not for coaches with a Can-West pass, as per Can-West protocol. <u>Volunteers</u>: A limited number of free lift tickets are available on a first come first serve basis to parents/supporters who volunteer for event positions.

<u>Volunteers</u>: Without volunteers, we can not run a successful event. We always welcome help from parents of other clubs. Event Cancellation: If an event is cancelled on the weekend of the event, each athlete registered will be refunded all but \$20 of his or her total entry fee. This is because the organizing committee still needs to pay the officials a portion of their compensation.

Injury Refund: Should an athlete get injured during training for the event and cannot compete, the athlete will be refunded registration fees less a \$20 administration fee. Injured athletes must be a scratch at previous day's team leaders meeting to be eligible for a refund. An injury refund request must be accompanied by a CFSA accident report from the coach. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances will be considered at the discretion of the organizing committee.





<u>Liability and Accident Insurance</u>: All athletes, officials and other members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Competitors are required to have his/her own medical and life insurance and a valid competitor license. The organizing committee, Jasper Freeride, Marmot Basin, the Alberta Freestyle Skiing Association, and the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association shall not be responsible for accidents, injuries, damaged equipment or third party claims arising from training or competition during the event.
