The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Southern Alberta Freestyle Ski Club in partnership with the Alberta Freestyle.

- 1. The competition is comprised of two events.
- 2. All athletes must have a Can Free 3 license or higher.
- 3. All athletes must have a Freestyle Canada/NCCP certified Coach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury.
- 4. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.
- 5. The competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.
- 6. Entry for mogul & Slope Style competition is based on Provincial Series quotas with freestyle club head coach referrals.

SAT FEB 23, 2019- Slope Style Competition, Banquet

SUN FEB 24, 2019-Mogul Competition

Registration:

Licenses

Athletes are required to have a minimum Can Free 3 License http://freestyleskialberta.goalline.ca/event-search.php?cat=46

Lift Tickets

Using the form attached, each club will be required to pre-purchase lift tickets from Sunshine Village. Forms must be submitted one week prior to event to receive the discounted rate.

Team Leaders will be able to pick up ordered tickets from Guest Services-Upstairs Creekside.

Competition Registration

Registration will be located in the Flex Room-Sunshine Mountain Lodge in the Upper Village.

Athlete Bios – Athlete bios are mandatory at the time of registration – no bio... no bib. Bio sheet is attached at the end or will be available at registration.

Bib Deposit – There will be a **\$20 CASH ONLY** bib deposit. If a bib is lost or forgotten, there will be a \$20 replacement fee. An athlete's bib number must match event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

Refunds – Refunds will be processed for withdrawals prior to the generation of the competition start list less a \$25 administration fee. No refunds will be processed after each event's start list has been generated.

Aerial Qualifications – All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- 1. Signed Aerial Passports held by coach/athlete
- 2. Completed and signed qualification forms
- 3. Freestyle Canada qualification databank

Age Categories

According to the birth year, as of January 1st, 2019, athletes will compete in the age categories of U20, U18, U16, or U14. Under age athletes will compete in the U14 category.

U20- 18 & 19 years of age on January 1st, 2019

U18-16 & 17 years of age on January 1st, 2019

U16-14 & 15 years of age on January 1st, 2019

U14-12 & 13 years of age on January 1st, 2019
