


Event venues require lift access and foot traffic will be limited.

The tickets will be available at the lower mountain, Creek Side volunteer check in. Complementary lift tickets will be limited to one day and non-season pass holders.

Registration: Registration deadline is Monday, February 17, 2020. Athletes are responsible for their own registration. To register, please use the following link https://snowreg.com/#!/events/728-safc-timber-tour-club-comp-provincial-3 Registration is limited to 80 Provincial Athlete and 110 Club Athletes. Athletes will be registered on a first come first serve basis Please register early to avoid disappointment. Coaches should ensure all athletes registering for the event can safely ski the venues.

Competition Entry Fees:

Provincial Athletes: Entry fees per participant are: One or two events: \$190.

Club Athletes: Entry fees per participant are: \$155 for both events. All Club athletes must register to compete in both moguls and slopestyle events.

** Athletes that are entered in Provincial events cannot enter in Club level events as well.

Payment: Athletes are required to pay registration fees online at time of registration.

Rules: The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Southern Alberta Freestyle Ski Club in partnership with the Freestyle Alberta. Both the Provincial and Club competitions are comprised of two events- moguls and slopestyle. All Provincial athletes must have a Freestyle Canada/NCCP certified Coach present. All Club athletes must have a Freestyle Canada Certified coach present. All athletes/coaches must have Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. All athletes must have an active Club athlete membership. All athletes must have a valid CFSA license to compete (Provincial athletes: Can Free 3 or higher. Club athletes: Can Free 1&2 - Club Level)

Athletes that are entered in Provincial event cannot enter in Club level event.

<u>Aerial Qualifications:</u> All athletes must have up to date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athlete qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualifications will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- Completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

Format:

Provincial Athletes: Slope and Moguls are best of 2 runs.

Club Athletes: The slope course will have a variety of features/jumps. Moguls will be Aussie rules format with a long mogul section, one jump table, and few or no moguls in the final section. Slope and Moguls are best of 2 runs.

Age Categories:

Provincial Athletes: According to the birth year, as of January 1st, 2020, athletes will compete in the age categories of U20, U18, U16, or U14. Under age athletes will compete in the U14 category.

- U20: 18 & 19 years of age as of January 1st, 2020
- U18: 16 & 17 years of age as of January 1st, 2020
- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1st, 2020
- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2020

Club Athletes: According to the birth year, as of January 1st, 2020, athletes will compete in the age categories of U16, U14, U12, or U10. Under age athletes will compete in the U10 category.

- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1st, 2020
- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2020
- U12: 10 & 11 years of age as of January 1st, 2020
- U10: 8 & 9 years of age as of January 1st, 2020

<u>Athlete Bios:</u> Please submit completed athlete bios to the Head Coach. Coaches are to collect bios and hand in to the registration desk on training day (Friday) please see the attached bio sheet.

Bibs:

Provincial Athletes: Athletes should have received their Freestyle Alberta provincial bib in advance of this event. **Athletes are required to bring their bib to the event.** If an athlete has not received their bib, bibs will be available for purchase at this event for \$30 cash.

Club Athletes: Clubs are asked to provide their own athletes with bibs. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions. If clubs do not have access to bibs, SAFSC can loan bibs. For all bibs, a cash deposit of \$20.00/bib is required and will be refunded upon bib return.

<u>Banquet/Social (Saturday, February 29, 2020):</u> Please extend the banquet invite to your club membership in advance of registration deadline. The Banquet will be held at the Coast Hotel in Canmore, 511 Bow Valley Trail, Canmore, AB T1W 1N7. The Banquet will include a social, cash bar, guest speaker, dining, awards and raffle and silent auction. (The wagon of liquor is back!!) Doors open at 5:00pm.

Ticket Pricing: \$40/ticket for 13 years and up, \$30/ticket for 12 and under.
