Expectations:

- Continual improvement and development of NEF programming including preseason dry-land, on-snow training and water-ramp training

- Travel away to attend and coach at competitions
- Liaison with the NEF Board, Nitehawk Year-Round Adventure Park and Alberta Freestyle
- Act as an ambassador for NEF by enforcing and modelling team rules and expectations and by promoting the NEF ski club in the community
