Competition Entry Information:

Registration: Registration deadline is **Friday, January 14, 2022**. **Athletes are responsible for their own registration.** <https://snowreg.com/#!/events/club-comp-bow-valley-ssm-jan-28-30>. Registration will be capped at 100 athletes. Athletes will be registered on a first come first serve basis. Please register early to avoid disappointment. Coaches should ensure all athletes registering for the event can safely ski the venues.

Club Athletes: Entry fees per participant are **\$150 for both moguls and slopestyle events**. All Club athletes must register to compete in both moguls and slopestyle events.

Payment: Athletes are required to pay registration fees online at time of registration.

Rules: The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Bow Valley Freestyle Ski Team in partnership with the Freestyle Alberta. The Club competition is comprised of two events- moguls and slopestyle. All Club athletes must have a Freestyle Canada Certified coach present. All athletes/coaches must have Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. All athletes must have an active Freestyle Alberta Club athlete membership. All athletes must have a valid CFSA license to compete (Can Free 1&2 - Club Level).

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up to date qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athlete qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualifications will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- Completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

Format: The slope course will have a variety of features/jumps. Moguls will be Modified Development Moguls format with a long mogul section, one jump table, and few or no moguls in the final section. Slope and Moguls are best of two runs.

Athlete Age Categories: According to the birth year, as of January 1st, 2022, athletes will compete in the age categories of U16, U14, U12, or U10. Under age athletes will compete in the U10 category.

- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1, 2022
- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1, 2022
- U12: 10 & 11 years of age as of January 1, 2022
- U10: 8 & 9 years of age as of January 1, 2022

Bibs: Athletes are to purchase bibs through Freestyle Alberta prior to the club competition. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

Lift Ticket Purchase:

Competition lift tickets will be available to purchase on-site at Mt. Norquay. Please note you are attending the Bow Valley Freestyle Snow Rodeo Competition for discounted rates. See www.banffnorquay.com for further information.

Banquet/Social (Saturday, January 29, 2022):

Please extend the banquet invite to your club membership in advance of the registration deadline. The Banquet will be held at the Lone Pine lodge at Mount Norquay. The Banquet will include a social, cash bar, dining, awards, raffle and silent auction. Doors open at 5:00pm. There is also night skiing for anyone who is enthusiastic enough to go for more runs. This will be unsupervised. A shuttle bus is available from Norquay to your hotel, if required. Please note tickets must be purchased in advance in the registration link (*Purchased tickets are non-refundable*).

Ticket Pricing: \$30/ticket for 16 years and up, \$20/ticket for under 16. Please purchase in Snowreg when registering your athlete.

Athlete Bios:

Event Cancellation:

If the event is cancelled the weekend of the event, each athlete registered will be refunded all but \$20 of his or her total entry fee. This is to cover the costs of expenses incurred to set-up the event.

Injury Refund:

Should an athlete get injured during training for the event and is unable to compete, the athlete will be refunded registration fees less a \$20 administration fee. The coach should notify the registration desk the day the injury occurs in order to be eligible for a refund. A CFSA accident report should accompany the request for a refund. Any other requests will be at the discretion of the organizing committee.

Volunteers:

A Sign-Up Genius link will be sent prior to the competition for all vacant volunteer positions. A limited number of complementary lift tickets will be available to on-
