INVITATION

Freestyle Alberta (FA and Freestyle Canada (FC) are pleased to invite all freestyle ski athletes to attend the Canada Cup, January 5 to January 9, 2022. This is CANADA CUP stop number #1 in the Canada Cup Series presented by Toyo Tires.

Rules:

- 1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by the PSO in partnership with Winsport.
- 2. Rules are based on the 2021/22 Canada Cup Guidelines and governed overall by the FISInternational Competition Rules.
- 3. The competition is comprised of one slopestyle event and one big air event.
- 4. All athletes must have a minimum FC certified Air 4 or Supercoach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the event jury.
- 5. Oualification are required for all inverted manoeuvres.
- 6. The competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the official program.

The Calgary CANADA CUP follows the Priority registration policy for PSO teams and HPAD athletes as described in the Provincial athlete comp guidelines.

Entry Fees: (per participant)

- o \$305.00 + 5% GST and snow reg fees
- o Participants must register on-line. Payments are made online.
- o Registration Includes the Athletes Competition Bib

Field size: The field size is limited to 100 athletes.

Eligibility:

- There is no eligibility criteria, but coaches need to make sure athletes are ready to take on the course specifications and relative skill level. This is anopen category competition, there are no age categories.
- Priority Registration clause HPAD Teams (PSO and NextGen)

Winsport Covid Policy

All athletes, coaches, chaperones, parents, officials, or people participating or involved in the 2021 Calgary Canada Cup, must be fully vaccinated prior to the event, and have their vaccine passport available. Proof of vaccine will be required on Winsport premises. Without the vaccine barcode, the individual will not be permitted to compete or be involved in the event or beon the Winsport property. Refunds will not be given to individuals who cannot provide proof of their vaccine barcode.

Licences:

Athletes are required to have a minimum Provincial Athlete Licence https://www.freestylecanada.ski/en/membership/individual/

<u>Lift Tickets</u>: Lift tickets will be available for purchase each day of 'official' training and competition at Guest Services with presentation of competitor bib. The cost of a lift ticketwill be \$30.00+ GST for the full day. No half day tickets are available. Each competitor is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event. Coach lift tickets are complimentary max 2 per team.

Payment for lift tickets can be made in person at Winsport









Competition Office (Race Office):

The competition office will be in the Frank Day lodge theater. ALL coaches must check in their athletes on there behalf and collect their teams' bibs Masks are required when in the competition office. (Only coaches and Event personal will be allowed in the competition office)

Package/Bib Pickup:

Bibs can be picked up on Wednesday January 5, 2022 once registration opens by the athletes coach, no deposit is require

Bibs:

Bibs are included in the athlete's registration If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be a \$35 + GST replacement fee. If an athlete forgets their bib and bring the bib back the next day, there will be no refund. Bibs will be available for purchase at the competition office during the event, should an athlete lose or forget their bib and must be picked up by the coach. It is important that your bib number match your event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace yourbib, please ensure your coach updates the <u>on-site</u> race office. Bibs <u>must</u> be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competition.

Refunds:

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury the coach or parent must notify the race office and email jaredlinden@freestylealberta.ski & events@freestylealberta.ski to inform them that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the team captains meeting the day before the competition day. Athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is cancelled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided. (The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event). Aerial Qualifications:

All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The FC Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during team leaders meeting the day before each event with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualifications will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed aerial passports held by coach
- Completed and signed qualification forms
- FC qualification databank

Liability and Accident Insurance:

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in theevent shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches and officials must have a valid FC membership. The organizing committee, FA,, Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, Winsport and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

FORMAT OF EVENT:

HALFPIPE/ SLOPESTYLE

QUALIFICATION:

best of 2 runs, heats of 25 - 30.

FINAL:

Men & Women: Top 40% of Qualification field move to final with a minimum of 6 and maximum of 30, # of heats and # of athletes to be decided at the first Team Captains meeting - dependent on registration & final field sizes.

BIG AIR - Elimination Rounds

QUALIFICATION: 2 Rounds - (finals field size adjusted to 40%)

1st Round – All Competitors Shall Start. Out of the first round 10 Men and 4 Ladies shall advance to the finals

 2^{nd} Round – Out of the second round all remaining competitors shall start and top 10 Men/4 Ladies' scores shall qualify for the finals.

FINAL: Best 1 of 2 jumps.

Men & Women: Top 40% of Qualification field move to final with a minimum of 6 and maximum of 30, # of heats and # of athletes to be decided at the first Team Captains meeting – dependent on registration & final field sizes.

*Might be adjusted depending on the actual field. Any changes will be made at team captain's meeting.
