5. Qualification is required for all inverted manoeuvres.

Q1: 1 run, Top %50 of Final field size advances to Final. (ex. If final cut is 20 athletes, top 10 advance from Q1)

Q2: Same run order. 1 run. Top %50 of final field size Advances to finals. (if cut is 20 than top 10 advance from Q2) Athletes can use top score from either Q1 or Q2

FINAL Field Size: 40% of registered entrants each gender with a minimum of 6 athletes and a maximum of 20 athletes

The competition office will be located in the Main Lodge. Please check in each day of the event at the competition office to sign in, pick up your bib, purchase lift tickets and receive updates on event schedule.

**Lift Tickets:** Lift tickets Must be purchased in advance of training via <https://snowreg.com/#!/events/canada-cup-modm-jan-13-16-2022/store> Coaches will pick up each athletes lift ticket with each athletes Bib. The cost of a lift ticket is \$37.00/day + HST Athletes can purchase 1-4 days. Each competitor and coach is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event. **Lift tickets are non refundable**

### **Registration:**

### **Licences:**

Athletes are required to have a **minimum Provincial Athlete**

### **Competition office:**

The competition office will be located in the Main Lodge at Canyon Ski Resort.

**Bibs:** Will be included in the event registration ALL coaches must check in their athletes on their behalf and collect their teams' bibs. Masks are required when in the competition office. (Only coaches and Event personal will be allowed in the competition office)

Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

### **Package/Bib Pickup:**

Bibs can be picked up on Thursday January 13, 2022 once registration opens by the athletes coach, no deposit is required.

### **Bibs:**

Bibs are included in the athlete's registration. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be a \$35 + GST replacement fee. If an athlete forgets their bib and brings the bib back the next day, there will be no refund. Bibs will be available for purchase at the competition office during the event, should an athlete lose or forget their bib and must be picked up by the coach. It is important that your bib number match your event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure your coach updates the on-site race office. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competition.

**Refunds:** If requesting a refund before the event or end of the first day of training there is a 50% refund.

No Refund after the conclusion of the second day of training.

If the event gets canceled due to Covid, refunds will be given out within 3 weeks of the canceled event. Please understand there are set costs to the LOC in hosting the event and Refunds will be prorated after the LOC covers their losses.

**Aerial Qualifications:** All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in **all disciplines**. The FC Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during Team Leaders meeting the day before each event with the **coach** of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passports held by coach/athlete
- Completed and signed qualification forms
- FC qualification databank

**Liability and Accident Insurance:** All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition. All athletes' coaches and officials must have a valid FC Membership. The Organizing Committee, Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, Freestyle Alberta Ski Association, Canyon Ski Resort and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.
