Competition Entry Information

Date and Location: The competition will take place on February 25 - 27, 2022 at

Castle Mountain Resort Hwy - 774, AB, T0K 1W0 https://www.skicastle.ca

The competition office will be located in the Main Lodge upstairs. Please check in each day of the event at the competition office to sign in, pick up your bib, purchase lift tickets and receive updates on the event schedule.

Lift Tickets: Lift tickets will be available for registered athletes to purchase each day of training and competition at the ticket office. Junior tickets (13-17) \$65.96 Adult (18-64) \$87.95 Each competitor is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event.

Registration:

All registration is individual and to be done by the Athlete, spots are first come first serve. Registration deadline is February 20, 2022. Athletes are responsible for their own registration.

Entry fees per participant are \$220 for both days.

Age Categories: the age categories for judging, as of January 1st, 2022 are as follows.

U20 18 & 19 years of age,

U18 16 & 17 years of age,

U16 14 &15 years of age,

U14 12 &13 years of age,

Payment: Athletes are required to pay registration fees online at time of registration. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, ALL coaches must check their athletes in, and collect their team bibs. Masks are required when in the competition office. (Only coaches and Event personal will be allowed in the competition office)

Package/Bib Pickup:

Bibs can be picked up on Friday, February 25, 2022 once registration opens to the athlete's coaches. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

If an Athlete has not purchased a bib they must do so during there registration. The cost for a provincial bib is 35\$

Athlete Bio Please submit completed athlete bios to the Head Coach. Coaches are to collect bios and hand in to the registration desk on training day (Friday). Bio sheet is included in this invite, on the last page.

Rules:

The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Castle Mountain Freestyle Ski Club in partnership with the Freestyle Alberta. The Provincial competition is composed of two mogul events. All athletes must have a Freestyle Canada Certified coach present. All athletes/coaches must have Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. All athletes must have an active Freestyle Alberta Provincial athlete membership. All athletes must have a valid CFSA license to compete.

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up to date qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athlete qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualifications will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- Completed & signed qualification forms

Liability and Accident Insurance: All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition. All athletes 'coaches and officials must have a valid FC Membership. The Organizing Committee, Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, Freestyle Alberta Ski Association, Castle Mountain Ski Resort, and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second - or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

Volunteers:

A limited number of complementary lift tickets will be available to on-snow volunteers, if not a season pass holder.
