- All athletes must have a Provincial license or higher.
- All athletes must have a Freestyle Canada certified Coach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury.
- Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.

All athletes, officials, organizers and other members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. COVID - 19 Policy - Winsport

(a) COVID-19 Pandemic: The Event Organizer agrees to work cooperatively with WinSport to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 at Canada Olympic Park. The Event Organizer will ensure that the Event Organizer and everyone associated with the Sport Event respectfully follows all WinSport COVID-19 rules and guidelines, including without limitation those pertaining to the requirement to be fully vaccinated (as defined by Health Canada), negative COVID testing requirements, wearing of face coverings, social distancing, sanitization, capacity limits, and gathering restrictions, which rules and guidelines may change from time to time at WinSport's discretion. In addition, the Event Organizer shall adhere to, and shall ensure everyone associated with the Sport Event adheres to, all Federal and Provincial Government laws, regulations, health orders and guidance, and all City of Calgary Bylaws, pertaining to COVID-19 (collectively the "Government Health Regulations"). The Event Organizer shall have policies and procedures in place that adhere to WinSport's rules, as well as the Government Health Regulations, to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 at Canada Olympic Park. In addition, the Event Organizer shall ensure that all athletes, coaches, and others associated with the Sport Event follow health entry requirements for international travelers into Canada and shall ensure that such individuals follow the Government Health Regulations in a respectful manner to minimize the spread of COVID-19 in the local community and to maintain the reputation of WinSport and the Event Organizer within the local community. The Event Organizer understands that those who do not comply with WinSport's COVID-19 rules and guidelines and Government Health Regulations may not be permitted access to Canada Olympic Park or the Sport Event.

(b) Spectators: The Parties agree that due to COVID-19, the Parties will work together prior to the Sport Event to determine how many spectators, if any, will be permitted at the facility to watch the Sport Event. The Event Organizer agrees that any spectators that are permitted will be subject to WinSport's COVID-19 rules, including vaccination and negative testing requirements, as well as the Government Health Regulations.
