Freestyle Alberta (FA and Freestyle Canada (FC) are pleased to invite all freestyle ski athletes to attend the Junior Nationals, March 23 to March 27, 2022. This is JUNIOR NATIONALS.

Rules:

1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by the PSO in partnership with Winsport.
2. Rules are based on the 2021/22 Junior Nationals Guidelines and governed overall by the FIS International Competition Rules.
3. The competition is comprised of one slopestyle event and one big air event.
4. All athletes must have a minimum FC certified Air 4 or Supercoach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the event jury.
5. Qualification are required for all inverted manoeuvres.
6. The competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the official program.

Entry Fees: (per participant)

- o \$355.00 + 5% GST and snow reg fees
- o Participants must register on-line. Payments are made online.
- o Registration Includes the Athletes Competition Bib
- o Registration includes 1 banquet ticket per athlete

Field size: The field size is limited to 100 athletes.

Eligibility:

- Athletes must be selected by their own province

Licences:

Athletes are required to have a minimum Provincial Athlete Licence

Lift Tickets: Lift tickets will be available for purchase each day of 'official' training and competition at Guest Services with presentation of competitor bib. The cost of a lift ticket will be \$30.00+ GST for the full day. No half day tickets are available. Each competitor is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event. Coach lift tickets are complimentary max 2 per team.

Payment for lift tickets can be made in person at Winsport

Competition Office (Race Office):

The competition office will be in the Frank Day lodge theater. ALL coaches must check in their athletes on their behalf and collect their teams' bibs. Masks are required when in the competition office. (Only coaches and Event personal will be allowed in the competition office)

Package/Bib Pickup:

Bibs can be picked up on Wednesday March 23rd, 2022 once registration opens **by the athletes coach**, no deposit is required. **Athletes are not allowed in the competition office**

Bibs:

Bibs are included in the athlete's registration. If a bib is lost or forgotten, there will be a \$35 + GST replacement fee. If an athlete forgets their bib and brings the bib back the next day, there will be no refund. Bibs will be available for purchase at the competition office during the event, should an athlete lose or forget their bib and must be picked up by the coach. It is important that your bib number match your event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure your coach updates the on-site race office. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competition.

Refunds:

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury, the coach or parent must notify the race office and email collin@freestylealberta.ski to inform them that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the team captains meeting the day before the competition day. Athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is cancelled due to weather or exceptional circumstances, no refunds will be provided. (The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event). Please see the Can Freestyle Competition Guide for Rules and Procedures.

Aerial Qualifications:

All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The FC Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during team leaders meeting the day before each event with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualifications will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed aerial passports held by coach
- Completed and signed qualification forms
- FC qualification databank

Liability and Accident Insurance:

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches and officials must have a valid FC membership. The organizing committee, FA., Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, Winsport and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.
