Calgary Freeriderz, Freestyle Alberta and WinSport invites athletes, coaches and freestyle friends and families to attend the Freeriderz Challenge from February 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at WinSport's Canada Olympic Park.

The Freeriderz Challenge is part of Freestyle Alberta's Provincial Series and includes a Halfpipe event and two separate Slopestyle events. Both Slopestyle events will use the West Terrain Park with open training available on Friday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**ENTRY FEES** \$250 for all three events (plus GST)

**WAIVERS** A signed waiver must be completed for each athlete before accessing the park. Sign the waiver before arriving at the ticket window.

**BIB PICKUP** Athletes are required to purchase a 2023 Provincial Bib from Freestyle Alberta through SnowReg which they will use at all Provincial events during the season. The cost of the bib is \$35 + GST: <https://snowreg.com/#!/events/45767-freestyle-alberta-bib-2023>

Bibs can be picked up on Friday, Feb. 3, 2023 at registration after 10:30am. Bibs must be worn properly for all official on-site training and for the competitions.

**LOCATION** WinSport, 88 Canada Olympic Road Southwest, Calgary, AB Canada

**LIFT TICKETS** Discounted lift tickets will be available at Guest Services upon presentation of a competition bib and if the athlete appears on the submitted registration list. Athletes will need a Hill ticket to access the West Terrain Park. Athletes who are competing in the Halfpipe event will require an additional XL Park ticket to access the Halfpipe XL course.  
Competition Price:  
1) Hill Ticket: \$34 CAD/day + 5% tax (does NOT include Halfpipe XL Park)  
2) XL Park Ticket: \$30 CAD/day + 5% tax (includes Halfpipe and XL Slopestyle Park)

There are no refunds. To qualify for this competition pricing, athletes must appear on the registration list at Guest Services. Each competitor must have a valid lift ticket and Halfpipe XL park ticket/pass. Hill and XL Park tickets /passes are non-transferable.

Coaches and officials' hill & XL park ticket: Free and available at registration office or guest services (2 per team).

## **AGE CATEGORIES**

U14, U16, U18, and U20 will be the age categories for judging, as of January 1st, 2023

## **REFUNDS**

If requesting a refund before the event or end of training there is a 50% refund, minus SnowReg administration fees. There will be no refunds after the conclusion of the first day of training. If the event gets canceled due to Covid refunds will be given out within 3 weeks of the canceled event. Please understand there are set costs for CFRZ in hosting the event and refunds will be prorated after CFRZ covers their losses.

- All athletes must have a Provincial license or higher.
- All athletes performing inverted skills (flips, corks, bios, etc.) must have such maneuvers qualified by a coach who holds Freestyle Canada's Air 4 Evaluation. An Air 4 coach must be on site to coach such maneuvers, and have a copy of an athlete's aerial certification ready to present to the TD within 24hrs if requested.

## **LIABILITY**

All athletes, officials, organizers and other members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Calgary Freeriderz, WinSport, Freestyle Canada and Freestyle Alberta and any Sponsors, shall not be responsible for any issue with the organization or staging of the event including, but not limited to: accidents; damaged or lost equipment and belongings; and/or second or third-party claims. All participants are to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

**All competitors must wear helmets and competition bibs.**
