## REGISTRATION & COMPETITION RULES

**Registration:** Club field size will be limited to 100 athletes. All registration is individual and to be done per athlete, spots are first come first serve. Registration Deadline is Monday, February 27, 2023. Athletes (families) are responsible for their own registration. Coaches should ensure that all athletes registering for the event can safely ski the venues.

**Club Competition Entry Fees:** \$150.00 per athlete, plus 5% GST and SnowReg fees. All athletes are registered to compete in both moguls and slopestyle (\$150 includes both events).

**Payment:** Athletes are required to pay registration fees online at time of registration. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring. Check in is at the Registration office to collect bibs and pre-ordered, discounted lift tickets.

**Athlete CFSA License / Membership:** All athletes must have a valid CFSA license to compete. Club level membership is required.

**Age Categories:** Athlete's age for the purpose of categories is determined by their age on January 1, 2023. Medals will be awarded for U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 age categories.

- U8: 6 & 7 years of age as of January 1, 2023
- U10: 8 & 9 years of age as of January 1st, 2023
- U12: 10 & 11 years of age as of January 1st, 2023
- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2023
- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1st, 2023

**Bibs:** Bibs can be picked up on Friday, March 3, 2023 once registration opens to the athlete's coaches. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and competitions. If an Athlete has not purchased a Freestyle Alberta bib, they must do so during their registration. The cost for a new 2023 Club bib is \$35. Athletes get to keep their bib after the competition and it can be used at other club competitions. If you have purchased a bib at a previous club competition, you are not required to purchase another.

## Rules:

1. This event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Central Alberta Freestyle Ski Club in partnership with Freestyle Alberta.
2. All athletes must have a FC Certified coach present with Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury.
3. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. All athletes must have an active Club Athlete membership.

**Aerial Qualifications:** All athletes must have up to date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

**Bios:** Please submit completed athlete bios to the Head Coach. Coaches are to collect bios and hand in to the registration desk on training day (Friday). Bio sheet is included in this invite, on the last page.

**Banquet Saturday, March 4th:** We will be hosting a banquet at the Holiday Inn on Gasoline Alley. Start time is 6:30 pm. Doors open at 6:00 pm.

**Lift Tickets:** All tickets must be pre-purchased online no less than 24 hours in advance and walk ups to buy athlete tickets at the discount price at the ticket window will not be allowed. Each competitor and coach is responsible for the purchase of their own lift ticket for each day of the event. Lift tickets are non-refundable. Coaches will pick up each athlete's lift ticket from the competition office.

**Foot access passes** are available at the Guest Kiosk at Canyon Mountain Resort (1 day - \$10.50, 2 day - \$21.00) for anyone wanting to walk on the hill to watch the slopestyle competition (foot access does not give you access to the chair lift or T-bar, just walking foot access). Purchase on site.

**Volunteers Lift Tickets:** A limited number of free lift tickets are available on a first come first serve basis to parents/supporters who volunteer for event positions.
