REGISTRATION & COMPETITION RULES

Registration: Club field size will be limited to 110 athletes. All registration is individual and to be done per athlete, spots are first come first serve. The registration deadline is Monday, March 19, 2023. Please register early to avoid disappointment. Athletes (families) are responsible for their own registration. Coaches should ensure that all athletes registering for the event can safely ski the venues.

Club Competition Entry Fees: \$150.00 per athlete plus SnowReg fees. All athletes are registered to compete in both moguls and slopestyle (\$150 includes both events).

Payment: Athletes (families) are required to pay registration fees online at time of registration. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring. Check in is at the Registration office.

Athlete CFSA License / Membership: All athletes must have a valid Canada Freestyle Athlete License number to compete. Club level membership is required.

Age Categories: Athlete's age for the purpose of categories is determined by their age as of January 1, 2023 (midnight Dec. 31). Your age category is determined by your birth year, e.g., an athlete born in 2013 age is calculated as 9 and will be U10 (under 10). Medals will be awarded for the age groups below:

- U8: 6 & 7 years of age as of January 1st, 2023
- U10: 8 & 9 years of age as of January 1st, 2023
- U12: 10 & 11 years of age as of January 1st, 2023
- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2023
- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1st, 2023

Bibs: Bibs can be picked up on Friday, April 7, 2023 once registration opens. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and competitions. If an Athlete has not purchased a Freestyle Alberta bib, they must do so during their registration. The cost for a new 2023 Club bib is **\$35**. Athletes get to keep their bib and it can be used at other club competitions. If you have purchased a bib at a previous club competition, you are not required to purchase another.

Rules:

- 1. This event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Jasper Freeride Ski Club in partnership with Freestyle Alberta.
- 2. The event is comprised of two events club moguls and club slopestyle.
- 3. All athletes must have a FC Certified coach present with Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.
- 4. All athletes must have an active Club Athlete membership.

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up to date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athletes qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

Bios: Please submit completed athlete bios to the Head Coach. Coaches are to collect bios and hand in to the registration desk on training day (Friday). Bio sheet is included inthis invite, on the last page. Bios are used for announcing during the event.

Banquet - Saturday April 8: Everyone is invited to the banquet - athletes, coaches, families and friends! Please order your tickets by the registration deadline if possible so the organizer can plan, although late orders will be accepted. The banquet will be held at the Jasper Activity Center (303 Pyramid Ave). We will be hosting silent auction and a cash bar with wine & beer. Doors open 6:00 pm with dinner at 6:30 pm followed by awards.

Banquet ticket prices:

- \$30 for 13 years and over
- \$20 for 6 to 12 years of age
- Free for 5 years of age and under.

Lift Tickets:

- Competitors and families: Tickets may be purchased at the Marmot Ticket Sales Windows (lower chalet parking lot). Best deal: For season pass holders (from a ski hill with reciprocal agreement) show your ski pass to receive 20% off regular price (taxes not included), otherwise registered athletes can get 10% off of regular lift prices. Please refer to this link for regular prices: skimarmot.com.
- **Team Coaches:** For every 10 athletes registered from your club, 1 complimentary ticket is available for a team coach. This is not for coaches with a Can-West pass, as per Can-West protocol.
- **Volunteers:** A limited number of free lift tickets are available on a first come first serve basis to parents/ supporters who volunteer for on-hill event positions.

Volunteers: Without volunteers, we cannot run a successful event. We always welcome help from parents of other clubs. Event Cancellation and/or Injury Refund: Please contact Freestyle Alberta ASAP at <u>events@freestylealberta.ski</u> for the refund policy. If a cancellation is received on time, a full refund may be possible. Claims for any refund insurances must be made first.

Freestyle Alberta Refund Policy:

- If requesting a refund before the event or end of training there is a 50% refund, minus SnowReg administration fees
- No refund after the conclusion of the second day of training (athlete should not appear on the start list)

Liability and Accident Insurance: All athletes, officials and other members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Competitors are required to have his/her own medical and life insurance and a valid competitor license. The organizing committee, Central Alberta Freestyle, Canyon Ski Resort, the Alberta Freestyle Skiing Association, and the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association shall not be responsible for accidents, injuries, damaged equipment or third-party claims arising from training or competition during the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.
