Edmonton Freestyle Ski Club (EFSC) is seeking an experienced and dedicated Head Coach to lead and develop our Fundamentals, Freestylers, and CanFree athletes in a fun and safe environment. As the Head Coach, you will be responsible for creating and implementing recreational and competitive training programs, leading and mentoring our coaching staff, attending and coaching at competitions, and working with the EFSC Board to oversee club management.

Key Responsibilities include the following:

- Development and execution of year-round training opportunities for athletes including dryland training (trampoline, air bag, strength and conditioning, etc.), on snow training and other activities to support athlete development.
- Being the point of contact between board members, parent liaisons, and coaches to facilitate effective communication.
- Building and execution of the club calendar consisting of camps, competitions and all training.
- Ongoing creation and monitoring of on snow-groups based on coaching certifications, athlete abilities, and goals to support athlete growth and development.
- Develop a process for coach goal setting with athletes and periodic communication to parents.
- Management of coaches and assisting with hiring of additional coaches, as needed.
- Acting as the liaison between the coaching team and the EFSC Board.
- Work with our facility providers and assigned board members to develop mogul and slopestyle training venues.
- Effective, efficient, and timely communication with board members on team activities. Attend board meetings as requested.
- Consistent building and development of your own training and development and increase your own certifications and awareness of all facets of freestyle skiing
- Point of contact between Freestyle Alberta, other head coaches, and attending Freestyle Alberta meetings and events as required.
