

Coaching advertisement 2025

Ullr Big Mountain is a freeride team based in Lake Louise Alberta. We are looking for several coaching positions to be filled for the 2024-2025 season. Some of these are more dryland focused and some are on-snow positions--or could be a combination of both.

One of the best things about working with our club is there is a lot of work flexibility. Our contracts range from as few as 3 days in a season, or a few nights at Winsport, to about 50 coaching days. We also have bursaries to help with coach education. The positions listed below can be seen as separate or can be combined.

Position 1. We are looking for prospective **on-snow coaches** for winter 2024-2025. Skiing would usually be on weekends or on school holidays. Candidates with strong free-ski skills and off-axis inverts are ideal. Rail skills would also be a bonus but are not totally necessary. Female coaches would be a great asset and compensated accordingly.

Position 2. We are looking for prospective coaches with their Air **2 certification** (or willing to take this certification) to work our trampoline training in Calgary. This would be a commitment of about 4 - 6 hours a week starting in late August. Ideally, the coach will have had some experience as a slopestyle athlete and would be able to coach off-axis aerials up to 900s. (There are some opportunities for work over the summer, as well).

Position 3. We are looking for prospective coaches with their **air 3 and/or 4b certifications** to work at some of our water ramp and airbag training, as well as to work some of our winter sessions at Winsport. Summer and fall work might be sporadic and might range between 3 - 30 work sessions, or

Position 4. We are looking for a prospective **doubles aerials coach** for winter 2024-2025. Candidates would need their air doubles on water ramp or snow certification, and they would help athletes with their airbag/water ramp and on-snow invert progressions and tests. This might involve some travel to venues with a progression bag.

Position 5. We are looking for a general on-hill team manager or head coach. This will initially require at least a season of professional transition to orient to our philosophy and program delivery.
