<u>Club Competition Entry Fees</u>: Competition entry is \$160.00 per athlete, plus GST and SnowReg processing fees. Payment must be paid online at the time of registration. This fee is for competition entry only and does not include bibs, lift tickets, banquet tickets, etc. All registered athletes will compete in both moguls and slopestyle events.

Rules: This event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Jasper Freeride Ski Club in partnership with Freestyle Alberta. The event is comprised of two events -club moguls and club slopestyle. All athletes must have a FC Certified coach present with Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. All athletes must have an active Club Athlete membership.

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up to date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a randomselection of athletes qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

Age Categories: Athlete's age for the purpose of categories is determined by theirage on January 1, 2023. Medals will be awarded for U10, U12, U14, U16 age categories. Underage athletes will compete in the U10 category.

- U10: 8 & 9 years of age as of January 1st, 2025
- U12: 10 & 11 years of age as of January 1st, 2025

- U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2025
- U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1st, 2025

Athlete CFSA License / Membership: All athletes must have a valid CFSA number to compete.

Club level membership is required.

Bibs: Please remember to purchase your athlete's Freestyle Alberta Club Comp bib ahead of time. The cost is \$35 plus GST and SnowReg fees. These bibs will be valid across all Club Competition events for the 2024 season, not including Provincials. If this is your first club comp of the season, pick up your bib at the event registration desk. Proof of purchase may be required. https://snowreg.com/#!/events/2025-freestyle-alberta-club-comp-bib

Please extend the banquet invite to your club membership in advance of registration deadline. The banquet will be held at the Jasper Legion, 401Geike Street, Jasper, Alberta, T0E 1E0_Doors open 5:30 pm.

Banquet ticket prices: \$30 for all ages, Banquet tickets cannot be returned after they have been paid for. We have a limit of 150 tickets

We will be hosting a silent auction. Guests (Including children) have access to the games room for pool and darts. Under 18 need to leave by 9:00 PM.

Burger dinner with fries and salad. Drinks available at the bar. Meal includes vegetarian and gluten free options.

<u>Lift Tickets</u>: Competitors and families: Tickets may be purchased at the Marmot Ticket Sales Windows (lower chalet parking lot). Best deal: For season pass holders (from a ski hill with reciprocal agreement) show your ski pass to receive 20% off regular price (taxesnot included), otherwise registered athletes can get 10% off of regular lift prices. <u>Team Coaches</u>: For every 10 athletes registered from your club, 1 complimentary ticket is available for a team coach. This is not for coaches with a Can-West pass, as per Can-West protocol. Please register if you need a lift pass with the Volunteer Coordinator.

Marmot Basin has a no up-hill or walking policy. To get to the viewing areas you will need to ski/board and have a lift ticket.
