Wednesday, March 5, 2025 - Practice
Thursday, March 6, 2025 - SS qualifications *
Friday, March 7, 2025 - SS finals / HP competition (Night) *
Saturday, March 8, 2025 - BA competition

LICENSES

All athletes are required to have an active FIS number.

Coaches/athletes/officials that represent a Canadian team are required to have a valid FC license and all

requirements related to its validation (background check, appropriate training, mandatory NCCP modules).

LIABILITY AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the maneuvers being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches and officials must have a valid membership. The organizing committee, the P/TSO, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, the resort and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to always protect and safeguard their personal belongings.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please note that there will be **ZERO TOLERANCE** for any offensive language or behavior during the event. Any damages or disruption to hotel, facilities or other property related to this event will result in the offender(s) being immediately removed from the event.

In addition, the top 16 competitors in the current FIS points list (each event) will receive a personal spot.

FORMAT

HALF PIPE:

- Qualifications best of 2 runs: third of the field advance to finals
- Finals best of 2 runs

SLOPESTYLE:

- Qualifications best of 2 runs: third of the field advance to finals
- Finals best of 2 runs







BIG AIR

- Qualifications best of 2 jumps: third of the field advance to finals
- Finals best 2 of 3 jumps (2 different directions jumps counting)

REFUNDS

Refunds shall be in accordance with NAC 7.

SCORING

Freestyle Solutions Lite (formerly called World Cup Lite) scoring program will be used. Live scoring link will be distributed when available.

ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in cooperation with the National Associations' medical personnel identified on the entry form.

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

Copies of the Event Medical Plan will be available at the Race Office or upon request.

COMPETITION OFFICE

Located on the ground level of the daylodge in the CHEER ON CANADA section.

BIBS

- Bibs can be picked up during Competition Office hours.
- Must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.
- No deposit is required, but Teams will be held responsible if not returned and charged \$45 each.
- Volunteers will collect the bibs at the bottom of the course after Big Air and Half Pipe.
- It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring.
- Early return to Race Office







LIFT TICKETS:
