Competition Entry Information:

Registration: Registration deadline is Tuesday, January 20, 2025. Athletes are responsible for their own registration.

Registration will be capped for 80 athletes. Athletes will be registered on a first come first serve basis. Please register early to avoid disappointment. Coaches should ensure all athletes registering for the event can safely ski the venues.

Club Athletes: Entry fees per participant are \$180 for both moguls and slopestyle events.

Athlete registration includes a banquet ticket.

*We will not be refunding tickets for those athletes that choose not to participate in the banquet.

Payment: Athletes are required to pay registration fees online at time of registration.

Rules: The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Bow Valley Freestyle Ski Team in partnership with Freestyle Alberta. The Club competition comprises two events: moguls and slopestyle. All Club athletes must have a Freestyle Canada Certified coach present. All athletes/coaches must have Aerial Passport readily available to present to the event jury. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. All athletes must have an active Freestyle Alberta Club athlete membership. All athletes must have a valid CFSA license to compete (Can Free 1&2 - Club Level).

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up to date qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athlete qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualifications will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- Completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

Format: The slope course will have a variety of features/jumps. Moguls will be Modified Development Moguls format with a long mogul section, one jump table, and few or no moguls in the final section. Slope and Moguls are the best of two runs.

Athlete Age Categories: According to the birth year, as of January 1st, 2024, athletes will compete in the age categories of U16, U14, U12, or U10. Underage athletes will compete in the U10 category. Medals will be handed out for U10 to U16 categories only.

- · U16: 14 & 15 years of age as of January 1, 2025
- · U14: 12 & 13 years of age as of January 1, 2025
- · U12: 10 & 11 years of age as of January 1, 2025
- · U10: 8 & 9 years of age as of January 1, 2025

Bibs: Athletes are to purchase bibs through Freestyle Alberta prior to the club competition. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

Lift Ticket Purchase:

We have special event lift tickets for Mt. Norquay. You can purchase your tickets when you arrive at Mt. Norquay. Please relay you are with the Bow Valley Club Competition to get special event pricing as follows:

Coaches & Competitors age 13+: \$75

Competitors age 13 and under: \$41

Banquet/Social (Saturday, January 25, 2025):

The Banquet will be held at **High Rollers Bowling and Beer Hall in Banff** on Saturday, January 25, 2025, from 5:00-8pm. The restaurant is in the Clock Tower Village Mall at 110 Banff Ave, Banff, AB. It will include a pizza buffet, a pop bar for athletes, free bowling for kids and complimentary free play on pool tables, cash bar for adults, 50/50 raffle, and silent auction.

Doors open at 5:00 pm with dinner being served at 6:00 pm. Parking can be difficult in Banff, so you may want to consider walking, taking Banff Transit or taxi to the event. **Please note tickets must be purchased in advance via SnowReg.

Ticket Pricing: \$35/ticket for 17 years and up, \$25/ticket for 16 and under, kids 6 and under are free YOUR ATHLETE'S TICKET IS INCLUDED IN THEIR REGISTRATION.

Event Cancellation:

If the event is canceled the weekend of the event, each athlete registered will be refunded all but \$35 his or her total entry fee. This is to cover the costs of expenses incurred to set up the event.

Injury Refund:

Should an athlete get injured during training for the event and is unable to compete, the athlete will be refunded registration fees less a \$35 administration fee. The coach should notify the registration desk the day the injury occurs to be eligible for a refund. A CFSA accident report should accompany the request for a refund. Any other requests will be at the discretion of the organizing committee.
