The Freeriderz Challenge is part of Freestyle Alberta's Provincial Series and includes a Halfpipe event and two separate Slopestyle events. Both Slopestyle events will use the West Terrain Park with open training available on Friday, January 17th.

WAIVERS A signed waiver must be completed for each athlete before accessing the park.

BIB PICKUP Bibs will be available at registration for a \$20 bib deposit. Please have a cash bib deposit ready at registration. Bibs should be collected by each team or athlete and returned to the Race Office across from Guest Services

LIFT TICKETS Discounted lift tickets will be available at Guest Services upon presentation of a competition bib and if the athlete appears on the submitted registration list. Athletes will need an advanced access winter hill ticket to access the West Terrain Park and the Halfpipe.

Advanced Access Winter Hill Ticket: \$TBD CAD/day + GST There are no refunds. To qualify for this competition pricing, athletes must appear on the registration list at Guest Services. Each competitor must have a valid lift ticket with advanced access. Coaches and officials' Advanced Access ticket: Free and available at registration office or guest services (2 per team).

AGE CATEGORIES U14, U16, U18, and U20 will be the age categories for judging, as of January 1st, 2025

ATHLETE BIOS & PHOTO USE Submit completed athlete bios to the registration desk by 3:00 pm on Friday, Jan 17th. Please see the attached bio sheet. Photos will be taken during the event and will be shown during the banquet.

REFUNDS

If requesting a refund before the event or end of training there is a 50% refund, minus SnowReg administration fees. There will be no refunds after the conclusion of the first day of training and the athlete will be issued a DNS (did not start). Please understand there are committed costs for CFRZ in hosting the event and refunds will be prorated after CFRZ covers their costs.

RULES

These events are sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Calgary Freeriderz in partnership with Freestyle Alberta.

- Eligibility – AFSA’s provincial selection criteria applies for this provincial level competition. For questions about eligibility please contact Freestyle Alberta’s event coordinator Patrick Breault patrick@freestylealberta.ski
- All athletes must have a Provincial license or higher.
- All athletes performing inverted skills (flips, corks, bios, etc.) must have such maneuvers qualified by a coach who holds Freestyle Canada’s Air 4 Evaluation. An Air 4 coach must be on site to coach such maneuvers, and have a copy of an athlete’s aerial certification ready to present to the TD within 24hrs if requested.

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials, organizers and other members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Calgary Freeriderz, WinSport, Freestyle Canada and Freestyle Alberta and any Sponsors, shall not be responsible for any issue with the organization or staging of the event including, but not limited to: accidents; damaged or lost equipment and belongings; and/or second or third-party claims. All participants are to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

All competitors must wear helmets and competition bibs at all times during official training and competition

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. Calgary Freeriderz, Freestyle Alberta, Sponsors, and WinSport decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third-party claims during the staging of the event. Volunteers, Officials and Judges **must** have current Freestyle Canada memberships.

There will be space for spectators on the hill. Be aware that you will be on snow and outside, dress appropriately and respect the spectator boundaries provided by Winsport.
