REGISTRATION & EVENT INFORMATION

All registration is individual and to be done per Athlete, spots are first come first serve. Registration deadline is January 31st, 2025. Athletes (families) are responsible for their own registration.

Competition Entry Fees: \$180.00 for one event and \$220.00 for both events, per athlete, plus 5% GST and SnowReg fees.

Payment: Athletes are required to pay registration fees online at time of registration. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring. Check in is at the Registration office to collect bibs and pre-ordered, discounted lift tickets.

Athlete CFSA License / Membership: All athletes must have a valid CFSA license to compete. A Provincial level membership is required. Club level athletes may upgrade to a Provincial membership in SnowReg.

Age Categories: the categories for judging, as of January 1st, 2025 are:

- U20: 18 & 19 years of age
- U18: 16 & 17 years of age
- U16: 14 & 15 years of age
- U14: 12 & 13 years of age

Package/Bib Pickup: Bibs can be picked up on Friday, February 6, 2025 once registration opens to the athlete. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and competitions. If an Athlete has not purchased a Freestyle Alberta bib they must do so during their registration. The cost for a new 2025 provincial bib is \$35. To upgrade from a Club to Provincial bib is \$25. Athletes get to keep their bib after the competition and it can be used at other provincial competitions. If you have purchased a bib at a previous provincial competition, it is not required to purchase another.

RULES:

1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Freestyle Alberta (FO) and Central Alberta Freestyle Ski Club in partnership with Canyon Ski Resort.
2. Rules are based on Freestyle Alberta Competition Guidelines for Provincials competition
3. The Competition is composed of one Mogul and one Slopestyle competition.
4. All athletes must have a minimum Freestyle Canada certified Air 4 Coach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury.
5. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.
6. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

Aerial Qualifications: All athletes must have up to date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The technical delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during the team leaders meeting, the day before each event, with the coach of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- signed Aerial Passport held by coach/athlete
- completed & signed qualification forms
- CFSA qualification databank

Bios: Please submit completed athlete bios to the Head Coach. Coaches are to collect bios and hand in to the registration desk on training day (Friday). Bio sheet is included in this invite, on the last page.

Lift Tickets: All tickets must be pre-purchased online no less than 48 hours in advance and walk ups to buy athlete tickets at the ticket window will be charged regular ticket prices. Each competitor and coach is responsible for the purchase of their own lift ticket for each day of the event. Lift tickets are non-refundable. Athletes can pick up lift tickets from the competition office.

Foot access passes are available at the Guest Kiosk at Canyon for \$15 per day or can be pre purchased via sno-reg for \$10 +GST per day for anyone wanting to walk on the hill to watch the slopestyle competition (foot access does not give you access to the chair lift or t-bar, just walking foot access). Purchase on site.

Volunteers Lift Tickets: A limited number of free lift tickets are available on a first come first serve basis to parents/supporters who volunteer for event positions.

Any positions that are on the hill will require a lift pass.

Injury Refund: Please contact events@freestylealberta.ski ASAP to request a refund.

- If requesting a refund **before** the event or end of training there is a 50% refund, minus SnowReg administration fee
 - No refund after the conclusion of the second day of training
- *Athlete should not appear on the start list

Liability and Accident Insurance: All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the maneuvers being performed in training and competition. All athletes' coaches and officials must have a valid FC Membership. The

Organizing Committee, Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, Freestyle Alberta Ski Association, Canyon Ski Resort, and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second - or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.
