Please note the following information:

- Coverage is only given to IFSA Junior Events. IFSA Open events are NOT COVERED.
- All attending athletes must have a valid <u>Provincial Athlete Membership</u> to participate in Junior Freeride events.
- All coaches MUST have a valid Freestyle Coach Membership AND IFSA coaching license (L100 or L200)
- The CSA Junior Big Mountain Sanction application (attached) must be completed in full and submitted to <u>info@freestylecanada.ski</u> at least 14 days prior to the start of the specific event.
- All participants must have properly executed the CSA/FREESTYLE CANADA Waiver, Hold Harmless and Assumption of Rick Membership Documents and be able to immediately produce such documents upon request.

The CA and Freestyle Canada are also prepared to consider GL coverage for any member club to host IFSA Junior Big Mountain events upon receipt of an application setting out full details of the event, including specifics as to location, event management and control, details as to staffing and approval of the ski area/resort as well as approval of IFSA
