Position Overview

Freestyle Alberta is seeking a dynamic and organized Sport Development Coordinator to support the planning and delivery of the Freestylerz Festivals and Try Freestyle Days under the Every Kid Can Play Fund. This position involves coordinating exciting freestyle skiing experiences for youth across Alberta, ensuring smooth operations and a high-quality experience for participants.

The Sport Development Coordinator will work closely with Freestyle Alberta's Sport Director and Event Coordinator to bring these events to life while building strong relationships with local ski hills and the freestyle skiing community.

Key Responsibilities

- Event Planning & Coordination:
 - Assist with organizing and setting up Try Freestyle Days and Freestylerz Festivals at ski resorts across Alberta.
 - Coordinate with local ski hills to arrange event logistics and ensure requirements are met.
 - o Recruit and schedule coaches to staff the events.
 - Help manage event budgets and track expenses.
 - o Book accommodations for event staff and participants when needed.
- Event Execution:
 - Support on-site operations for event days, ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience for youth participants.
 - o Represent Freestyle Alberta as an ambassador for the program.
- Communication & Administration:
 - o Advertise events and create engaging content for social media platforms.
 - o Distribute and analyze post-event surveys to gather feedback.
 - Maintain accurate records and provide reports to the Sport Director and Event Coordinator.
