SAFSC is looking for an experienced **Head Coach** to join our team. The Head Coach will be responsible for supporting the Program Director in facilitation of programming both on and off snow. They will be the on-snow leader and will demonstrate a strong commitment to the development of all SAFSC athletes and coaches ensuring that safety is top priority in all training situations. Some expected responsibilities will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Implement training plans as defined by Program Director
- Establish athlete performance benchmarks through baseline testing progressing athletes throughout the season as required
- Implement goal setting techniques throughout the year for each athlete (November, December, review season in March/April)
- Maintain an athlete database which will include the ongoing evaluation of athlete training plans to ensure yearly targets are achieved based on individual goal setting
- Support Program Director in the recruitment of athletes and coaches and in developing programs for athlete retention and recruitment
- Active year round coaching for on snow and dry land
- Open and clear communication with parents and athletes at a minimum, on a bi-weekly basis
- Manage all head coach emails including those from inquiring families, current families, etc.
- Maintain confidentiality when dealing with coaches, athletes and the Board of Directors
- Display appropriate behaviours at all times as a representative of the Club.
