- Strong **big mountain skiing skills** and comfortable on jumps/cliffs is required.
- Freestyle Canada **Air Certifications** is a strong asset.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Ability to act as a **RISE Ambassador** of the LLSCs to build and strengthen a positive team culture and environment.
- **CSIA, ACA** certifications and/or experience in **IFSA** competition venues are an asset.
- Aptitude in other area such as sport psychology, strength & conditioning, etc. are an asset.



EXPECTATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Coach athletes 12 – 18 years of age, full days Saturday and/or Sunday.
- Deliver all programming with a high level of safety and strong focus on fun.
- Work closely with other coaches to maximise engaging training environments.
- Participate in regular coach development sessions post athlete training.
- Maintain effective communication with Head Coach, parents and athletes.
- Track athlete progress through quick and simple digital records as instructed by Head Coach.
- The ideal candidate lives (or is willing to relocate) between Calgary AB and Golden BC.
- The majority of training is based out of Lake Louise, however additional coaching opportunities may be possible at IFSA competitions and/or weekday evenings at Winsport.
