Our program develops U12-U19 athletes through structured freeride environments that combine **technical skiing, terrain awareness**, line choice, air awareness, and **competition preparation**. Through coaching, exploration, and progressive mountain experiences, athletes build the confidence, judgment, creativity, and independence that define strong freeriders.

As part of the Lake Louise Ski Clubs family, which includes three clubs: Grizzlies, Race, and Freeride, we provide **progressive athlete development pathways** in a safe, supportive mountain environment where athletes build skiing skills, confidence, independence, and a lifelong passion for the mountains.

ABOUT THE U15/U19 COACH ROLE

As a **U15/U19 coach**, you will be **paired with another coach** and share responsibility for the development of one athlete group throughout the season. Coaching pairs will be built to balance strong technical ski coaching with freeride and IFSA competition experience, so different coaching strengths can work together to develop complete athletes while learning from each other.



EXPECTATIONS

- Coach athletes 12–18 years of age on weekends.
- Deliver **safe, fun, progressive freeride programming** focused on technical skiing, terrain use, air awareness, line choice, and mountain decision-making.
- Work closely with the coaching team to build **engaging training environments** that use each coach's strengths while balancing challenge, **creativity, athlete independence, and appropriate risk management**.
- Maintain effective communication with the Head Coach, parents, and athletes.
- Track athlete progress using quick, simple digital records as instructed by the Head Coach.
- Most training is based out of Lake Louise, with additional coaching opportunities possible at IFSA competitions and weekday evenings at Winsport.
- Air 2/3 certified coaches may have **additional opportunities** to work with athletes on trampoline, airbag, and water ramps through the fall and winter



QUALIFICATIONS

- Freestyle Canada **Fundamentalz** certification, heavily discounted certification course available in-house, if not already certified.
- Experience coaching athletes or teaching multi-week ski programs.
- **Freeride skiing ability** is required; the level expected may vary depending on coaching strengths and role fit.
- Freestyle Canada **Air certifications** are a strong asset.
- Strong communication skills.
- **Ski instructor** certification, such as CSIA or equivalent, is a strong asset.
- Experience coaching or participating in IFSA competitions is an asset.
