Through coaching, exploration, and progressive mountain experiences, athletes build the confidence, judgment, creativity, and independence that define strong freeriders.

As part of the Lake Louise Ski Clubs family, which includes three clubs: Grizzlies, Race, and Freeride, we provide **progressive athlete development pathways** in a safe, supportive mountain environment where athletes build skiing skills, confidence, independence, and a lifelong passion for the mountains.

ABOUT THE HEAD COMPETITION COACH

As **Head Competition Coach**, you will lead the Club's IFSA competition program. This **salaried position** runs approximately from early November through mid-April and requires regular travel to IFSA events. Working closely with the Head Coach and coaching team, you will oversee competition planning, coach coordination, athlete preparation, and event logistics throughout the season.



EXPECTATIONS

- **Lead the club's IFSA competition coaching**, including athlete preparation, event planning, and competition season coordination.
- Support regular Lake Louise training before and during the IFSA competition season.
- Attend and coach at most IFSA competitions during the season, **requiring regular travel to competition venues**.
- Coordinate competition logistics, schedules, coach assignments, and communication with athletes and families.
- Maintain simple competition records, including athlete feedback, videos, and score breakdowns.
- Work closely with the Head Coach and coaching team to bring competition feedback back into athletes' regular training.
- Air 2/3 certified coaches may have **additional opportunities** to work with athletes on trampoline, airbag, and water ramps through the fall and winter.



QUALIFICATIONS

- **Extensive experience coaching IFSA competitions**, including venue inspection, line selection, athlete preparation, competition strategy, and performance review, is required
- Strong organizational, communication, and **leadership skills** are required.
- Freestyle Canada Fundamentalz certification, heavily discounted certification course available in-house, if not already certified.
- Strong freeride skiing ability is required.
- Previous IFSA or equivalent freeride competition experience as an athlete is a strong asset.
- Freestyle Canada **Air certifications** are a strong asset.
- Ski instructor certification, such as CSIA or equivalent, is a strong asset.
